
Neighborhood has high unemployment and crime rates

Acquired health insurance through Marketplace, but is underinsured





Food Insecurity



Using the social needs assessment, Onc Social Worker (SW) connects Pt. to the cancer center's food pantry

Transportation barriers



to receive transportation assistance (i.e., parking vouchers) while receiving Tx

Financial Hardship







Housing Insecurity



Discussions about financial assistance for OOP costs & finding safe, stable housing for both her and her daughter



SW gets approval for Pt.

SW connects Pt. w/ legal aid counselors to review insurance coverage, employment benefits, & disability program


